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## WORK OF PERSONS DEPRIVED OF THEIR LIBERTY – SELECTED ISSUES FROM LABOUR LAW AND PENAL LAW

The article concerns selected aspects of the employment of people deprived of their liberty. The Author focuses on issues related to the specific nature of the employment of this group, including the modification of their employee rights. Moreover, current statistics, which show a dramatic decline in employment of the detained in prisons, are presented. Particular attention is also paid to post-penitentiary policy issues and recent legislative changes relating to the judgment of the Constitutional Tribunal and government initiatives aimed to encourage potential employers to hire this group of people.
