This course will introduce students to the European Banking Law and Investment Law and enable them to analyze the relevant legal issues. This course will provide an introduction to the Financial Market Law in the European Union: banking regulation, supervision, resolution, deposit guarantee and framework for investment. This course is designed to familiarize the student with the key principles relating to the European Banking Law, legal provisions concerning the access to the banking activity, rules of prudential supervision of credit institutions and prudential requirements for credit institutions, EU objectives and policy of investments. The classes will put theoretical concepts into action through case studies. Students who wish to obtain a basic knowledge of the new European Regulatory and Supervisory Architecture in the EU financial market after the global crisis will also benefit from this course. Moreover it is recommended that those who wish to explore the current regulatory status, the questions raised by the new rules and the evolution of this essential move towards a more integrated European Financial Market.
