## ROAD SAFETY AS AN ELEMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

Road safety is an element of public safety, which can be determined by identifying dangers threatening public interests. Systematic approach to road safety leads to the creation of a new quality, thanks to the link between its components, which include: behavior, a vehicle and road infrastructure.
