**RESPONSIBILITY FOR MARITIME SAFETY AND THE ENVIRONMENT
IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS
OF THE INTERNATIONAL SAFETY MANAGEMENT CODE (ISM CODE)**

The International Management Code for the Safe Operation of Ships and for Pollution Prevention (ISM Code) aims to improve maritime safety by introducing an obligation to develop, implement and maintain a company's safety management system – a documented system, which enables effective implementation of safety and environmental protection standards by the company's personnel. The state administration confirms the fulfillment of ISM Code requirements by issuing a Document of Compliance. It is the basis for issuing Safety Management Certificates for a fleet owner, which is the main evidence that the ship is complying with the requirements of the Code and a guarantee that the company has made efforts to limit the level of risk associated with the operation of its ships to an acceptable level.
