CHOICE OF THE WAY OF JUSTICE (ON THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE SUPREME CHAMBER OF CONTROL)

The article is devoted to the issue of the responsibility of the President of the Supreme Chamber of Control in the context of the mode of constitutional responsibility before the Tribunal of State and criminal liability before ordinary courts. It is connected with the request made by Polish deputies to put the President of the Supreme Chamber of Control before the Tribunal of State and the request of prosecutors to waive the immunity of the President in order to allow criminal proceedings. The Author has discussed the issue of the confluence of responsibilities, especially against the background of the decisions of the Constitutional Tribunal, as well as the consequences of the existing legal loopholes concerning the mode of the constitutional responsibility of the President of the Supreme Chamber of Control, including proposals for new statutory regulations.
